Rate change

As previously communicated with you through letter and email on July 4, 2023, there will be a one-time interest rate adjustment on September 1, 2023. The rate set for the period September 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023 is 7.90%. Going forward, rates will continue to be set on January 1 and July 1 each year.
